Hawaii State Public Library System DS-11 Passport Checklist

Remember to Bring:

1. APPLICANTS

- Applicants must be present.
- Ages 16 & 17: Must be with one parent with valid ID.
- Ages 15 & Under: Must be with both parents or legal guardians with valid IDs. If only one parent, bring one of the following:
 - Birth Certificate listing only one parent
 - o Certified Sole Legal Custody Order
 - Absent parent's notarized <u>Form DS-3053</u>, <u>Statement of Consent</u> & photocopy of the front and back of the ID
 - o Form DS-5525, Statement of Special Family Circumstances
 - Death Certificate of the other parent

2. FORM DS-11

• Fill out with black ink. Do not sign!

3. PROOF OF CITIZENSHIP

- State-Issued Birth Certificate, Consular Report of Birth Abroad (CRBA), Naturalization Certificate or Citizenship Certificate, PLUS a PHOTOCOPY
- OR a previously-Issued U.S. passport. (PLUS, Birth Certificate or Certified Guardianship Court Order for Minor under 16)
- A valid passport must be submitted. If a valid passport is lost or stolen, <u>Form DS-64</u> in addition to <u>Form DS-11</u>

4. PHOTO ID & PHOTOGRAPHY

- Hawaii Driver License, Hawaii State ID, U.S. Military ID, OR Foreign Passport. Out-ofstate ID requires an additional ID.
- PLUS, a single-sided PHOTOCOPY of the front and back of the IDs on 8.5"x11" white paper
- Ages 16 & 17: One parent's ID & applicant's if available
- Ages 15 & Under: Both parents' IDs.

5. PASSPORT PHOTO

- One 2"X2" Color Photo
- White Background
- No Eye Glasses, Uniform or Headgear

6. TWO FEES BY CHECK

- Separate CHECKS or MONEY ORDERS for PASSPORT FEE & EXECUTION FEE. NO CASH or CREDIT CARD
- 1. Table for PASSPORT FEES Payable to: **U.S. DEPARTMENT OF STATE** (Valid for 10 years for adults & 5 years for minors under 16)

- 2. EXECUTION FEE Payable to: **DIRECTOR OF FINANCE STATE OF HAWAII**
 - \$35.00 Execution Fee Per Applicant. (Combine family execution fees: # of applicants x \$35)

BORN ON OR AFTER FEBRUARY 28, 1983 & DERIVED CITIZENSHIP THROUGH PARENT'S NATURALIZATION?

Bring ALL of the following if you don't have a certificate of citizenship:

- Parent's Naturalization Certificate, PLUS a photocopy
- Child's Certified Foreign Birth Certificate. If not in English, also a notarized translation
- Child's Permanent Resident Card OR I-551 Stamp
- Parents' Certified Marriage Certificate. If not in English, also a notarized translation
- Copies of 1040 tax return, for the years from the child's arrival in the U.S. until the parent's naturalization that show the child as a dependent of the citizen parent.
- Proof of legal, physical custody such as parent's divorce or custody decree if applicable

BORN ABROAD TO U.S. CITIZEN PARENT(S)?

Bring ALL of the following if you don't have a CRBA or a Certificate of Citizenship:

- Your Certified Foreign Birth Certificate
- Parents' Citizenship Documents
- Parents' Certified Marriage Certificate
- Notarized <u>Form DS-5507</u>, <u>Affidavit of Physical Presence or Residence</u>, <u>Parentage</u>, <u>and Support</u> signed by the US Citizen Parent(s)
