Conklin, Melanie. A Perfect Mistake. (Relationship Skills)

After the events of a single night leave one of Max's best friends in a coma and the other one shutting him out, Max—believing he is to blame—teams up with new friends to uncover what happened. Gr. 3-7

J Fic Draper

Draper, Sharon. Out of My Heart. (Self Management)

Melody Brooks, a 12-year-old with cerebral palsy, convinces her parents to allow her to attend a summer camp for kids with disabilities. Gr. 5+

J Fic Fipps

Fipps, Lisa. Starfish. (Self Management)

Bullied and shamed her whole life for being fat, twelve- year-old Ellie finally gains the confidence to stand up for herself, with the help of some wonderful new allies. Gr. 4-6

J Fic Formato

Formato, Jaime. Roll for Initiative. (Self Management)

Twelve-year-old Riley steps out of her older brother's protective shadow and behind the Dungeon Master's screen, running D&D campaigns for her friends and learning to be independent and self-reliant. Gr. 3-6

J Fic Guerrero

Guerrero, Tanya. How to Make Friends with the Sea. (Self Awareness)

Moving to the Philippines with his zoologist mother, twelve-year-old Pablo struggles with anxiety while his mother fosters an orphaned child with a facial anomaly. Gr. 3-7

J Fic Horne

Horne, Maggie. Hazel Hill is Gonna Win This One. (Responsible Decision Making)

When Hazel discovers Ella is being harassed by golden boy Tyler Harris, she has to choose between winning the school-wide speech competition and doing the right thing. Gr. 4-6

J Fic Ireland

Ireland, Justina. Ophie's Ghosts. (Social Awareness)

Discovering her ability to see ghosts when a cruel act ends her father's life and forces her to move in with relatives, young Ophelia forges a helpful bond with a spirit whose own life ended suddenly and unjustly. Gr. 4-8

J Fic Keller

Keller, Tae. The Science of Breakable Things. (Social Awareness)

Middle schooler Natalie's year-long assignment to answer a question using the scientific method leads to truths about her mother's depression and her own cultural identity. Gr. 5-6

Korman, Gordon. Slacker. (Responsible Decision Making)

When eighth-grader Cameron Boxer creates the Positive Action Group he intends it as a diversion to fool everyone into letting him continue to concentrate on his video-gaming--but other kids are taking it seriously. Gr. 3-7

Kuyatt, Meg Eden. Good Different. (Self Management)

Orphaned and homeless, fourteen-year-old twins Vick and Tara, who is autistic, go up against a crime lord and her four-legged robotic army, with help from their robotic dog, Daisy. Gr. 5-6

Ava finds an old pencil and discovers that it will answer factual questions. She and her best friend Sophie have a great time until the pencil reveals a truth that Ava would rather not know. Gr.4-6

O'Neill, Kay. The Moth Keeper. (Responsible Decision Making)

Being a Moth Keeper is a huge responsibility and a great honor, but the new Moth Keeper decides to take a break from the moon and see the sun for the first time. Graphic Novel. Gr. 3-7

Ortega, Claribel. Frizzy. (Self Awareness)
